

CSACI TRAVEL GRANT GUIDELINES

The grants will be made based on the judgment of the executive of CSACI prior to each meeting. The funds will be distributed to all approved applicants.

ALLERGY AND IMMUNOLOGY RESIDENTS:

1. Travel grants are available to residents and fellows enrolled in Canadian programs of Allergy and Clinical Immunology.
2. Travel grants for these residents will be made available for travel and expenses incurred while attending:
 - the Annual meeting of CSACI
 - the Annual meeting of AAAAI

Travel grants are not available for any other meetings or conferences.

NOTE: Travel grants are not available for those who live within the metropolitan area of the conference.

3. The amount of Travel Grant available for these two meetings is as follows:
 - AAAAI: up to \$750.00 Canadian
 - CSACI Annual Scientific Meeting:
 - *All first year residents: up to \$1000*
 - *Presenter of abstracts: up to \$1000*
 - *For those who are not presenting: up to \$750*
 - Original receipts are required to support the claim of expenses.
 - The program director must sign the Travel Grant application to verify their enrolment in an Allergy training program.

4. Funding from other sources:

There must be disclosure for any other funding.

The above guidelines are dependent on the financial position of the society. Travel grants may be cancelled at any time if finances do not allow disbursement of these travel grants.

BASIC SCIENCE TRAINEES:

1. Travel grants may be made available to Basic Science Trainees involved in significant Allergy/Immunology research.
2. Travel grants for approved Basic Science trainees will be made available for travel and expenses incurred while attending:

BASIC SCIENCE TRAINEES (continued):

- The annual meeting of CSACI only:
 - *Up to \$750 (basic science trainees applications may be prorated depending on funds available)*
- Original receipts are required to support the claim of expenses
- The program director must sign the Travel Grant application to verify their enrolment in a Basic science-training program.

Travel grants are not available for any other meetings or conferences.

NOTE: Travel grants are not available for those who live within the metropolitan area of the conference.

3. Funding from other sources:

There must be disclosure of any other funding.

The above guidelines are dependent on the financial position of the society. Travel grants may be cancelled at any time if finances do not allow disbursement of these travel grants.

ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS:

1. Travel grants are available to Allied Health professionals who are members of the Allied Health section of CSACI.
2. Travel grants for these Allied Health members will be made available for travel and expenses incurred while attending:
 - The Annual meeting of CSACI only
 - *Up to \$500 per applicant*
 - Original receipts are required to support the claim of expenses

Travel grants are not available for any other meetings or conferences.

NOTE: Travel grants are not available for those who live within the metropolitan area of the conference.

3. Funding from other sources:

There must be disclosure of any other funding.

The above guidelines are dependent on the financial position of the society. Travel grants may be cancelled at any time if finances do not allow disbursement of these travel grants.
